1. Event details

- What is the purpose of the fundraising initiatives?
 - The primary goal is to raise funds through sponsorship, donations and other means support school development to better equip the learners in their academic programme. This includes providing state-of-the-art sporting facilities to help our teams excel even further along with other needed school infrastructure.

2. Fundraising goals

- What is the fundraising target for the celebration?
 R16.5 million over the next three years
- How will the funds be used?
 - The main goal with reaching our target of R16.5 million is to upgrade school and sporting facilities and infrastructure
- What is the breakdown of costs for the celebration itself?
 - The costs will vary from event to event and will be advertised and marketed accordingly.
- Will the funds be managed by the school or a third-party organisation?
 - All funds raised will be held by the Ebenezer Trust.

- Will there be any recognition for donors and sponsors?
 - Yes. With the different tiers of sponsorship comes varying degrees of exposure either via RGHS newsletter, social pages, year book and local media. You will also receive a Section 18A Certificate for income tax purposes
- Is there a tiered system of recognition?
 - Yes. There are 3 tiers of sponsorship in many of our sponsorship opportunities. Each tier varies in value sponsored and duration of sponsor. The tier also has mentioned within it what the donor/sponsor will receive for his/her contribution/sponsorship
- Can donations be tax-deductible, and will Section 18A certificates be provided?
 - Yes, certificates will be provided by the Ebenezer Trust

 - It would be dependent on which event you would be assisting RGHS with.

5. Sustainability and legacy

- How will the fundraising initiative benefit the school in the long term?
 - The fundraising will assist in infrastructure upgrades which will be able to better service the future generations that will attend RGHS for years to come.
- Is there a plan for ongoing support after the birthday/anniversary celebration?
 - At the end of 2025 the 165 Birthday will become the 165 Club where those who donated/sponsored will be kept up to date with how and when the funds will be used going forward. They will also be kept up to date on the progress of the funds that has been raised via our website
- Will some funds be allocated for future school projects and initiatives?
 - Yes, all the funds that will be raised will be used for short, medium and long term goals that will help improve the school infrastructure for future Rhenishers.

 - We hope that with the facilities that will be built from the 165 fundraising that we can assist smaller schools for their sports events that they are unable to host due to a lack of facilities.

8. School's Legacy and History

 - RGHS is the oldest girls' school in the country which was founded by early settlers in Stellenbosch. The school opened on 1 May 1860 hosting 8 girls in its first year. The school has blossomed over the years, forever diversifying to improve how it services the community of Stellenbosch by providing outstanding education, exceptional sport and cultural opportunities. We need to celebrate the importance of this government run school that is going above and beyond with so many contributions from parents and community members that help make this school great. We need to celebrate the distance this school has gone since 1860 and proud of its future.
