Rhenish netball is on the rise! In recent years, we have fostered an environment that is not only competitive but also focused on developing life skills, social connections, and the benefits of physical activity.

At Rhenish, netball is more than a game - it's about creating a sense of belonging and acceptance. Team spirit is valued as highly as performance excellence, and every player's commitment to the team is vital to its success.

Our achievements reflect this ethos, with recent highlights including an U18 Cape Winelands representative and numerous Western Province Action Netball players.

Netball at Rhenish welcomes every girl who wants to play. Each player finds a home in her team, where she can forge lasting friendships and strong bonds.

Regular practices ensure our teams are well-prepared for league matches and prestigious tournaments. Key events include the All Girls' Festival (where we proudly finished 2nd in 2024) and the annual derby with Collegiate Girls' from Gqeberha. Our 'A' teams also compete in the renowned Clanwilliam Netball Tournament.

Rhenish Netball is dedicated to developing players who are committed to growth, hard work, and excellence. We believe that success comes through determination, discipline, and teamwork - qualities that our players carry with them beyond the court.



TENNIS

At Rhenish, we offer both team tennis and social tennis to cater to players of all levels. Social tennis is perfect for those who play purely for enjoyment - some players don't even own a racquet when they start. However, as they get into the game, they quickly develop a love for tennis and see their skills improve. Team tennis, on the other hand, is for those with a more competitive edge, offering a chance to challenge themselves and compete at a higher level.

We compete in Boland League and participate in various prestigious tournaments, with standout performances including:

Additionally, Rhenish has seen several players earn tennis scholarships to top universities in the USA, opening doors for both academic and athletic success.
